Tenison Road Traffic Management & Environmental Enhancement Scheme

Contributions from CB1 have been secured to mitigate the traffic impact of the development. Cambridgeshire County Council has been working with stakeholders to develop a traffic management and environmental enhancement scheme for Tension Road. The objectives of the scheme are to:

- Minimise the adverse impact of increasing traffic in the area.
- Enhance the environmental qualities of the neighbourhood.
- Maintain safety and pedestrian/cycle comfort levels.
- Maintain permeability and connections within the area.

Additional maintenance funding has also been secured for the resurfacing of the carriageway in Tenison Road and the replacement of the traffic signals at the St.Barnabas Road and Devonshire Road junctions. The traffic signal replacement work will include the provision of pedestrian facilities at both junctions.
